The companies CSTTAO, AIG, CONTI-LINES (on behalf of ERCO) and Port of Antwerp Bruges International are pleased to announce the signing of a partnership agreement for the realisation of the Jambaar project.

This project is part of the Plan Sénégal Émergeant and the implementation of the National Port Strategy and aims to make Senegal's ports efficient and to make Senegal a port and logistics hub by 2035.

The Jambaar project consists of

- developing a Multipurpose Multimodal Terminal to increase the productivity of the Port of Dakar
- setting up a sea-river service between the port of Dakar and the secondary ports, in order to promote multimodal transport and relieve congestion in the city of Dakar;
- develop Senegal's secondary ports, in order to unlock the industrial, agricultural and mining potential of the regions of Saint-Louis, Fatick and Ziguinchor.

The total investment for this project is estimated at between CFAF 95 and 115 billion, and a bid for the first part has been submitted to the Port Autonome de Dakar.

La Laiterie du Berger and Waterleau sign a contract for wastewater treatment for the Dalima Richard-Toll and Sandiara production units.

La Laiterie du Berger, Senegal's single producer of dairy products made from milk collected exclusively from Senegalese farmers, has called on Waterleau to build two wastewater treatment plants. The installations will enable the producer of the popular Dalima dairy products to comply with the Senegalese environmental code and discharge standards.

The capacity of the wastewater treatment plant in Richard-Toll and Sandiara is 300 m³/day and 600m³/day respectively. Construction is scheduled to begin in the second half of 2023, with commissioning foreseen within 12 months.

The wastewater will be treated using a biological treatment process based on Waterleau proprietary KROFTA® DAF and LUCAS® SBR technology.

11. BIO-SOURCING - IRESSEF

BioSourcing and IRESSEF announce signing a Memorandum of Understanding for setting up a joint venture of biotherapeutics production in Senegal

Senegal is one of the pioneering countries in Africa for improving the health of populations as well as for the implementation of local production units, particularly for vaccines. However, another class of biotherapeutics, such as monoclonal antibodies, is essential in the fight against pandemics, cancer, or the scourge of metabolic diseases such as diabetes in Africa. These biotherapies are part of the list of essential medicines established by the WHO. However, they are inaccessible to the majority of the African continent due to their production costs and the availability of the product. Indeed, investment in production infrastructure using current technologies and to produce the necessary volumes in West Africa would require billions of euros. To meet this challenge, Bio-Sourcing, a Belgian biotechnology company, has developed a disruptive technological platform making it possible to produce biotherapeutic drugs, in particular monoclonal antibodies, in large volumes, from the pharmaceutical breeding of specialized goats and the treatment of their milk. This paradigm shift in bioproduction makes affordable local production possible, and increases access to these drugs for countries with still limited resources. **The BioSourcing-IRESSEF joint venture project aims to provide an answer to the needs for biotherapeutic drugs in West Africa**.

In their joint venture project, also open to other Senegalese and international partners, Bio-Sourcing and IRESSEF intend to establish, in Senegal, a pharmaceutical unit for the production of biomedicines from goat breeding, dedicated to this purpose and the treatment of their milk in order to purify the proteins that will make up the biomedicines. The partners will bring their own know-how and will seek from financial backers the funds necessary for the realization of the project. This aims, firstly, to make treatments for breast cancer and diabetes more accessible to the population. In their joint venture project, also open to other Senegalese and international partners, Bio-Sourcing and IRESSEF intend to set up, in Senegal, a GMP production unit of goat's milk derived biotherapeutics. The partners will bring their own know-how and will seek other partners and investors to raise funds required to implement the project. The main goal is to make more accessible to the Senegalese population and the one of West Africa, innovative and efficient treatments as such as biotherapeutics, in particular and firstly, against breast cancer and diabetes.

36. ULB COOPERATION x ECLOSIO – UNIVERSITE CHEIKH ANTA DIOP DE DAKAR

Eclosio (NGO of the University of Liège), FUCID (NGO of the University of Namur), Louvain Coopération (NGO of the Catholic University of Louvain) and ULB-Coopération (NGO of the Free University of Brussels) have been joining forces since 2016 in the implementation of numerous projects, in the South as well as in the North, under the name Uni4Coop.

In Senegal, the cooperation programme is led by ULB-Cooperation and Eclosio. It is based on the development of an agro-ecological model that guarantees respect for the environment, the preservation of natural resources, improved productivity and increased income from agriculture, as well as meeting the growing market demand for healthy products. In collaboration with universities and research centres, producers participate in the dissemination of soil restoration and biodiversity preservation practices. The diversification of income sources for farming families is promoted



primarily through support for the economic activities of young people and women, also on the outskirts of protected areas (such as the Niokolo-Koba National Park) and marine protected areas (such as those of the Sine Saloum Biosphere Reserve).

The Cheikh Anta Diop University of Dakar aims to be a development university and is committed to participating fully in the socio-economic promotion of Senegal through local development, particularly in rural areas, with the "UCAD Rurale" concept. Thus, for some years now, UCAD has been setting up demonstration and production sites (scientific, technical, agricultural), places of exchange, interaction and cooperation between the university, local communities, the business world and the economic, technical, administrative and scientific decision-making centres.

It is therefore quite natural that the Belgian university NGOs of the UNI4COOP consortium and UCAD Rurale intend to deepen their collaboration in a concern for scientific rigour and for the benefit of the populations of Senegal.

37. UNIZIMA/UNIVERCELLS x UNIVERSITE LIBRE DE BRUXELLES – UNIVERSITE AMADOU MATHAR MBOW x UNIVERSITE CHEIKH ANTA DIOP DE DAKAR x UNIVERSITE DU RWANDA

Unizima announces new academic partnerships, strengthened cooperation between academic and private actors from Senegal, Rwanda and Belgium around a joint Master in Biotechnology.

In order to support the capacity building needed to enable autonomous vaccine production in Africa, Unizima, Cheikh Anta Diop University of Dakar (Senegal), the University of Rwanda, Amadou Mathar Mbow University of Diamniadio (Senegal) and the Université Libre de Bruxelles have decided to strengthen their collaboration by supporting the creation of an inter-university Master's in Biotechnology. This Master's degree, which will be complementary to the training provided in Rwanda, will be supported by practical professional internships in the field, organised in the laboratories of the Univercells group in order to enable students to acquire a first practical experience of the world of bioproduction.

On 20 April, within the framework of a Round Table organised around university partnerships, Unizima S.A. ("Unizima"), Cheikh Anta Diop University ("UCAD"), the University of Rwanda ("UR"), Amadou Mathar Mbow University ("UAM") and the Université Libre de Bruxelles ("ULB") decided to agree on



the signature of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) during the Dakar mission. The aim of this initiative is to encourage the construction of a joint Master's degree at the various universities offering a differentiated and quality training programme to support the strengthening of the necessary skills and to guarantee the production of vaccines locally in Africa.

This South-North collaboration therefore strengthens cooperation between the academic and private sectors and responds to the need to develop the skills required for the proper functioning of vaccine and therapeutic product production plants in Africa. While the primary aim is to anticipate the provision of a competent workforce, qualified in the latest biotechnology and bioinformatics technologies, this inter-university cooperation also aims to achieve closer collaboration between the laboratories of UCAD and ULB in order to contribute jointly to scientific research on malaria.

By signing this university partnership agreement between Senegal, Rwanda and Belgium, the partners wish to concretise their ambition to advance towards a common goal by promoting the reinforcement of academic training specific to the world of biotechnology, the sharing of industrial technical expertise, while supporting the scientific research effort to fight against the health problems specific to Africa.

The particularity of this cooperation also resides in the will to make different academic and private actors collaborate with the same objective of :

- Nourish scientific reflection and advance research work on malaria between the different universities;

- Encourage the strengthening of skills by developing joint and complementary masters in biotechnology between Africa and Europe and promote quality training;

- To make available industrial technical expertise in biotechnology through practical field placements that promote a better understanding of the industrial reality.

Because making health care accessible and affordable for all also requires the development of quality training supported by the creation of university partnerships and close collaboration between academia and the private sector for vaccine sovereignty in Africa.

BATAO means "to tell" in Hindi. With the BATAO project, we want to tell stories through films: Senegalese films, Belgian films, African films, European films.
